RIDER INFORMATION

All riders please remember to bring a form of ID which will be returned when you return the race number.

Under 18 riders – please ensure you have completed the Parental Consent Form which has been emailed separately and submit it to the registration desk.

Rider to Note CTT Regulation 14

(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

(j) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

Rider to Note CTT Regulation 15

All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard such as SNELL B95, ANSI Z90.4, AUS/NZS 2063:96, DIN 33-954, CPSC or EN 1078.

Rider to Note CTT Regulation 17:

Signing-on Sheet and Signing-out Sheet

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official signing-on sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s); and (ii) sign the official signing-out sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.



Doping Control

This event may be subject to a Doping Control. As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed, you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required, you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.

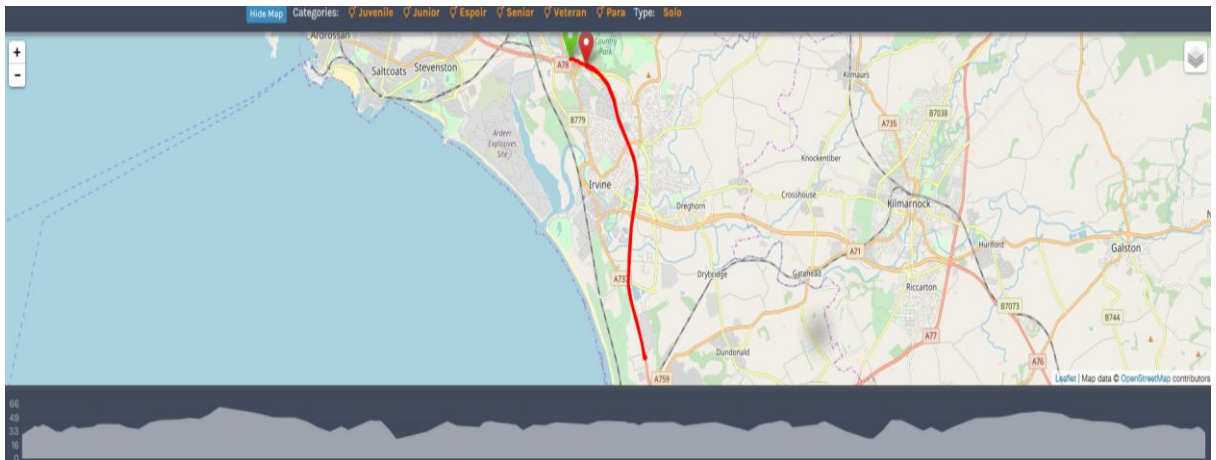
COURSE

The course starts at street lamp No R5 opposite entrance to Eglinton Country Park. Riders will follow A78 south under two interchanges to turn at Dundonald Camp roundabout. Riders then retrace to finish on slip road at Eglinton interchange.

Marshals are there to direct riders, not stop traffic. Please obey the Highway Code and the rules of Scottish Cycling.

Please do not warm up on the course. This will result in a DQ.
