

Route from HQ to start



To The Start: -

Turn Left out of the rugby Club road and then right on to B2592, down to the traffic lights (approx 1 mile). At the trafic lights turn left on to Station Rd at the next set of traffic lights turn left on to A5086 (Lamplugh Rd) this takes you upto the roundabout on A66 (approx 2 miles). At A66 roundabout take first left start is 1/2 mile along

Course details

START at painted mark on kerb against drain at east end of the first lay-by to the east of Simonscales Bridge over the A66. This lay-by is 0.75 miles from the roundabout junction with the A5086 Cockermouth/Egremont road. Proceed from the start along the A66 in an easterly direction to the A591 Keswick/Bothel roundabout junction (12.1 miles). Encircle roundabout and retrace along the A66 to the roundabout at the Cockermouth/Egremont junction(24.8 miles) where turn left taking the A5086 Egremont road to FINISH beyond entrance to The Sheep

Centre at painted mark in line with large A5086 sign (25 miles).

Local regulations

Cycling Time Trials – North D.C. 2023- A66 Courses

The following Local Regulations have been approved by the National Committee in accordance with Regulation 38 Any breaches may lead to disciplinary action being taken.

CTT Regulation 14 Competitors Machine – FRONT WHITE LIGHT & REAR RED LIGHT.

NO COMPETITOR shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine **A WORKING FRONT WHITE LIGHT**, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users. **A WORKING REAR RED LIGHT** must be affixed to the rear of the machine, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

CTT Regulation 17: Signing-on Sheet and Signing-Out Sheet:

- a. The Competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official Signing-on Sheet when collecting their number.
- b. In Type A events a competitor must return to the events HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the even and must (i) return their number and (ii) sign the official Signing–Out Sheet

Local Reg No 5

For the duration of the event, competitors must not ride past the timekeepers, except when actually competing.

Local Reg No 6

Any competitor making a 'U' turn in the vicinity of the start or finish will be disqualified from the event.

Local Reg No 9

No parking on the A66 except in a designated lay-by. No competitor parking in the Start/Finish lay-by on any A66 course.

Local Reg No 15

Riders must keep to the left-hand side of the road except when overtaking. Failure to comply with the above may lead to disqualification.

Local Reg No 17

On the L1010, competitors must not access the Start Lay-By via the carriageway break and ride West bound on the East bound carriageway. This will lead to disqualification from the event.

IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE:

Riders must give their number at the finish and elsewhere on the course if requested.

Riders must NOT STAND in the road at the start or finish. (This constitutes obstruction and is a breach of Regulations).

Riders must NOT ride with their heads down.

Helmets:

All competitors **MUST** wear a HELMET of HARD/SOFT SHELL construction that conforms to a recognised Standard (See Regulation 15).

NOTE - ALL of the above MUST be included on the start sheet for the rider's information.

The following local regulations / recommendations / information applies to

the event promoters.

Local Reg No 7

The start sheet must include the designated point for the completion of the Signing on and Signing-Out sheet, receiving any further instructions and the collection of numbers [see Regulation No 27(e)(xi) and 27(h)(i)]

Local Reg No 11

For all events in the North District at least 50% of the entry fees (less levies) must be allocated to awards.

In Addition to the above

A copy of the warning sign 'Head Down' should be displayed at event H.Q. or start.

Safety: In the interests of safety, marshals should wear fluorescent clothing.

Risk Assessment: The event must comply with the Risk Assessment relevant to the course being used, also any instructions/warnings etc. for the rider on the Risk Assessment must be included on the start sheet.

'Event Safety Form' to be completed and returned to the Asst Sec for Open Events with the copy of the result sheet.

Course: The course details on Police Forms and Start Sheets must be identical to the details as enclosed.

Event Officials: A competent person must be appointed as the "Start Line Official" who will "manage" the start line and assist the timekeeper

Sheep Centre, Cockermouth, permission must be obtained from the staff to use the car park for the headquarters for events on L2511 and L505.

The following recommendations should also be adopted by event promoters

- 1 All timekeepers be offered a fee of not less than £20.00.
- 2 The first rider off should be a member of the promoting club.

<u>Note</u> – Regulation 27 refers to the Duties of Event Secretaries a General Guide is also given on page 43 of the current handbook, a copy and checklist is enclosed.

NOTES TO COMPETITORS:

17. Signing-on Sheet and Signing-out Sheet

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official signing-on sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s); and (ii) sign the official signing-out sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

This event may be subject to a Doping Control As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
