Headquarters

Headquarters is Stannington Village Hall What3words /// tile.extremes.bluff Postcode NE61 6EL

Please be aware that this is a residential area - park with consideration for others and remember not everyone loves an early start on a Sunday morning!

Route from HQ to start

The start is on Church Road, which is halfway between the two small roundabouts in the centre of Stannington Village. Cunningly, if the Church is in front of you, you're probably on Church Road and need to head a little further away from Stannington to find the start.

Course details

START at lay by on the left, approximately 30 metres past First School, West of Stannington, on Church Road and proceed on Church Road towards Tranwell Village, via Bets Lane and then through Tranwell until T junction with the B6524. Turn left onto B6524 and continue along B6524 until taking the second left, Gubeon (sign posted Ponteland). Continue past Kirkley Hall and Gardens onto North Road and onto Ponteland. Turn left onto Berwick Hill Road. Proceed up to Berwick Hill and north east past Horton Grange to the T-junction with the old A1 /Blagdon road. Turn left on the old A1 and continue down slip road to join the A1 northbound dual carriageway. Proceed north for approx. 1/3 mile to take the slip road leading to Stannington Village, To FINISH on the slip road 25 metres before the Stannington Village sign.

NOTES TO RIDERS re COURSE CONDITIONS

Road surface conditions may change depending on the season, weather or condition of the road. It is the riders' responsibility to ride in such a manner that allows them to ride safely and with consideration to other road users at all times.

Head down riding is dangerous.

It is the responsibility of the rider to check the Risk Assessment on the day to be aware of any extra hazards or

changes they should be aware of. The course will be inspected again on the day before and on the day, but agricultural work means that course conditions may change at any time.

Local regulations

Riders:

- Be aware of sharp bends on the Stannington to Tranwell stretch of the course, in particular the right hand bend at St. Mary's Park. Take extra care at all road junctions, in particular passing through St Mary's, Tranwell Village and Ponteland.
- No U-turns to be made in the vicinity of the timekeeper(s).
- No dismounting in the finishing area and ensure speed is reduced prior to the 20MPH limit in Stannington.

GENERAL RIDER SAFETY NOTE:

Every Competitor MUST have, fixed to their machine, both a front and rear facing, working light. These must be clearly visible (Regulation 14)

Every rider MUST wear a helmet that conforms to current Safety Standards (Regulation 15) and it is their

responsibility to ensure it fits correctly and is in good condition/undamaged.

The Start is just within the village 20mph limit, but this should not present a problem from a standing start. Riders are asked to show respect to local residents in terms of noise, and other possible causes of offence such as changing in public view. Toilets are available in the Village Hall.

NOTES TO COMPETITORS:

17. Signing-on Sheet and Signing-out Sheet

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official signing-on sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s); and (ii) sign the official signing-out sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

This event may be subject to a Doping Control As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
